2024-2025 Administrator Checklist

To become a National Board Professional Development School or District for the 2024-2025 school year:

1. Complete and submit the <u>Statement of Intent Form</u> to hold your school's spot with the NBRC by July 19, 2024. More information will be shared once this form is received.

2. Recruit teachers and/or counselors for a professional development cohort centered on completing National Board Component 2: *Differentiation in Instruction* and Component 4: *Effective and Reflective Practitioner* during the 2024-2025 school year using our <u>NBPDS Informational Flyer</u>. You can also schedule an informational webinar with our office, or else share the <u>Awareness PowerPoint</u> from our website.

3. Complete and submit the <u>School Registration form</u> for your candidates and return it to the National Board Resource Center by August 30, 2024.

4. Instruct **new** cohort members to apply for the <u>Illinois National Board First Time</u> <u>Candidate Fee Subsidy</u>. This subsidy enables the payment of fees for all eligible teachers and counselors for the National Board process. <u>If you are a returning</u> <u>NBPD School, returning cohort members from the previous school year are already</u> <u>approved and do not need to reapply for the state subsidy. You will need to pay</u> <u>your annual \$75 to NBPTS before we can send payment.</u>

5. Assure all cohort members sign an individual <u>Teacher Agreement</u> so there is an understanding of cohort member responsibilities. Keep a copy of each for your records and email a copy to the NBRC at NBResourceCenter@ilstu.edu.

Invoicing: The National Board Resource Center will invoice your district \$7,250 per cohort—includes up to 15 educators. \$7,250 is **due by August 30, 2024**. **Discounted rate of \$6950 if paid by July 31.**

Note: If your district has schools categorized as ESSA Tier 3 (Targeted supported) or ESSA Tier 4 (comprehensive support), funds allocated may be used for the purpose of payment for the National Board Professional Development School/District program. Other district/school Professional Development funds may be used as well.
