What does it mean to be a National Board Professional Development School?

- Educators from the National Board Professional Development cohort work with a dedicated cohort facilitator to focus on specific school needs or agreed-upon school or district improvement goal.
- Twelve sessions, provided either at the school/district or virtually, which focus on completing two National Board components per year.
- Goal-setting meeting and training for the administrator, teacher liaison, & National Board facilitator.
- Ongoing, 9-month support for the cohort from the National Board Resource Center (NBRC) at Illinois State University.
- \$1,900 candidate fee subsidy for National Board Certification process paid directly by ISBE for each qualified educator participant.
- Opportunities to articulate teaching practices aligned with the Danielson Framework for Teaching.
